## Use of draftversion style

The draftversion style prints a large "DRAFT" watermark on each page of a document. To use this option it must be included using \usepackage and switched "on" with the command \DraftVersion is the preamble as follows:

```
\usepackage{draftversion}
\DraftVersion
```

This style also defines a *note* command that of syntax

```
\note{Text of note}
```

The Text of note will be printed in the document is *italic* only when the \DraftVersion command is in operation.

## Features

The watermark "DRAFT" is implemented in POSTSCRIPT using a feature local to dvips, so will only work when processed by dvips and printed or viewed using ghostscript. It has no effect when using xdvi except for a harmless warning message. This is a known feature of xdvi with no known fix.

It also does *not* work with pdflatex where it is ignored without warning, so to make a pdf file first need make ps file with dvips and the convert it to pdf with ps2dpf.

dvips -f myfile | ps2pdf - myfile.pdf

will do the trick!
