Use of fullpage style

The fullpage style sets the printable area of the page to have 25 mm margins all round and the headers and footers extending into the top/bottom margins. This results is the maximum practical amount of text on a single page. This style is sensitive to the paper size and will work with any paper size that LaTeX understands. For A4 papers it should be used as follows:

\documentclass[a4paper,12pt]{article}
\usepackage{fullpage}

This style is a replacement for a4full which only works for A4 paper in portrait mode. Note: This style is "reasonable" for 12pt documents but for smaller fonts it tend to put far too much text on a single line. It does however work well with 10pt when combined with twocolumn mode.
