

Use of draftversion style

The draftversion style prints a large “DRAFT” watermark on each page of a document. To use this option it must be included using `\usepackage` and switched “on” with the command `\DraftVersion` in the preamble as follows:

```
\usepackage{draftversion}
\DraftVersion
```

This style also defines a *note* command that of syntax

```
\note{Text of note}
```

The Text of note will be printed in the document is *italic* only when the `\DraftVersion` command is in operation.

Features

The watermark “DRAFT” is implemented in POSTSCRIPT using a feature local to `dvips`, so will only work when processed by `dvips` and printed or viewed using `ghostscript`. It has no effect when using `xdvi` except for a harmless warning message. This is a known feature of `xdvi` with no known fix.

It also does *not* work with `pdflatex` where it is ignored without warning, so to make a pdf file first need make ps file with `dvips` and the convert it to pdf with `ps2pdf`.

```
dvips -f myfile | ps2pdf - myfile.pdf
```

will do the trick!
