

## Use of fullpage style

The `fullpage` style sets the printable area of the page to have 25 mm margins all round and the headers and footers extending into the top/bottom margins. This results in the *maximum* practical amount of text on a single page. This style is sensitive to the paper size and will work with any paper size that L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X understands. For A4 papers it should be used as follows:

```
\documentclass[a4paper,12pt]{article}
\usepackage{fullpage}
```

This style is a replacement for `a4full` which only works for A4 paper in portrait mode.

*Note: This style is “reasonable” for 12pt documents but for smaller fonts it tends to put far too much text on a single line. It does however work well with 10pt when combined with `twocolumn` mode.*
